



Patient Information on Whole-body Scintigraphy

Examination procedure

Registration

Please first register at reception. You will then be directed to nuclear medicine.

Preparation

We will first place an intravenous line in a vein in your arm. You will receive an amount of nuclear medicine tracer adjusted to your body weight through this line.

Early images

The required early images are taken after the injection.

Waiting period

After the early images have been taken, you may leave the practice. Our team will give you the exact time at which you should return for the later images.

During the waiting period, the administered tracer accumulates in the body. Please drink the water you brought with you—approximately 1.5 litres—as evenly as possible. You may eat and drink and otherwise continue your usual activities during this time.

Important information about toilets

While you are in our practice, please use only the nuclear medicine toilet. Once you have left the practice between examination stages, you may use any public or private toilet.

Late images

Please return to our practice punctually at the agreed time. The required late images will then be taken.

Discussion of results

After all images have been completed, Mr Koenig will discuss the examination and explain the result to you. The written report will then be prepared and sent to your referring physician.
